Legal research at the Law Library

The Law Library of Victoria has two free online courses for Victorian legal practitioners to help brush up on your case law and legislation research skills. You can access the course through the Law Library of Victoria website's <u>Legal research eLearning</u> page for registered users.

Each unit is self-paced and can be completed when it works for you. They contain step by step instructions, information on the use of different platforms, tips on search techniques, links to further information and short quizzes to check understanding.
